We are committed to incorporating the International Standard Organization's International Workshop Agreement [IWA] 42 guidelines.

Our primary accountabilities are to seek ways to address scope 3 emissions, as set out in ISO 14064-1, following the appropriate protocol set-out for each particular category:



For our next iteration our focus will be on elements identified as being reasonable to be addresses by Very Small Entities [VSEs] also know as micro businesses, specifically: 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7 and 15 above.

We will publish our targets and share in accordance with the guidance given in ISO's IWA 42 and ISO 14064-1:2019, such as:

Redesigning and developing products and services to reduce their life cycle emissions

Promoting, supporting and facilitating the circular economy (e.g. reuse, repair, refurbishment, repurposing, recycling)

Collaborating with other organizations and sector or industry partners to strengthen and align procurement and purchase requirements

Prioritizing suppliers based on their climate strategy, past performance and transparency of emission data

Prioritizing low-carbon mobility solutions (e.g. public transport, electric vehicles with appropriate charging infrastructure) and reducing the need for personal transportation through urban planning

Ensuring financial investments, including assets and pension funds, are aligned with climate strategy and net zero commitments
